## School and Community

The American International School in Abu Dhabi (AISA), was founded in 1995 to serve the educational needs of the local and expatriate residents of Abu Dhabi. AISA is administered by Educational Services Overseas Limited (ESOL), an organization that also manages fully accredited schools in Dubai, Egypt, and Cyprus. The school is centrally located in the Embassy Zone of Abu Dhabi, approximately 10 kilometers from the city center. AISA currently enrolls 1,273 students in grades K-12 and has a full time teaching staff of 145 , which provides an ideal student to teacher ratio. The total enrollment in the high school is 346 students, with 86 students in the Class of 2012. AISA's classes are co-educational from grades K-5. All middle and high school classes are gender segregated. The high school student body represents 50 nationalities. Approximately $33 \%$ of the students are from the UAE, $15 \%$ from the USA, $15 \%$ from Europe, $12 \%$ from the surrounding Middle East, $7 \%$ from Asia, 7\% from Canada, 7\% from Oceania, and 4\% from South Africa. School facilities include one main high school building with 32 classrooms, a library, a drama center, three computer labs, two art rooms, six science labs, two gymnasiums, and a cafeteria.

## AISA Mission Statement

Our mission is to produce reflective, responsible, independent, and respectful students, who possess strong global citizenship, integrity, and an appreciation for lifelong learning. Through our academics and extra-curricular programs, we strive to provide a quality education that gives students the ability to reach their full potential, both academically and personally, and to make a worthwhile contribution to society.

## Accreditation

AISA is fully accredited by Middle States Association of Schools and Colleges (U.S.A.) and the Council of International Schools. AISA is licensed by the U.A.E. Ministry of Education. AISA is authorized by the International Baccalaureate Organization to offer the International Baccalaureate Diploma as well as the Primary Years Program. The High School Counselor is a member of the Overseas and National Association for College Admission Counseling and abides by their Statement of Good Practice.

## Academic Curriculum

AISA provides an American style college preparatory program in the English language for all students in grade 9-12. In grade 10, students may either continue with the college preparatory program for the remainder of high school or pursue the one-year International Baccalaureate Preparatory Program. This program prepares students to apply for the two-year International Baccalaureate Diploma Program in grades 11 and 12, which was instituted at AISA in 1996.

## College Preparatory Program - Graduation Requirements and Grading Scale

All students pursuing the college preparatory program are required to complete 24 course credits. One credit is awarded for each year-long course completed with a passing mark of a D- or above. Only courses taken at AISA are factored into the GPA. The required 24 course credits must be completed in the following areas:

* Arab students must complete four years of Arabic, four years of Islamic Studies, and one year of Arabic Social Studies, as per the requirement by the U.A.E. Ministry of Education. A passing grade of a $60 \%$ is required in all classes except for Arabic where a $50 \%$ and higher is passing.

## International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme

AISA is an IB World School and is authorized to offer the International Baccalaureate Organization. Grade 11 and 12 students have the opportunity to complete this highly regarded two-year program. All students who complete the IB Program will also be awarded an AISA high school diploma in conjunction with their IB Diploma, awarded by the IBO. ## Class Rank

The American International School in Abu Dhabi only provides a rank for the top two students in the graduating class. Each year, a valedictorian and a salutatorian from the college preparatory program and a valedictorian and salutatorian from the IB Diploma Program are recognized at the graduation ceremony. A student must be enrolled their entire junior and senior year to be considered for valedictorian or salutatorian.

## Extracurricular Activities

The academic experience at AISA is accompanied by an array of after school activities. AISA encourages students to participate in the six athletic programs, which include soccer, basketball, track and field, badminton, softball, and volleyball. In addition, AISA offers MUN, Amnesty International, choir, drama club, art club, international club, school newspaper, yearbook, student council, student ambassadors, and a literary magazine.
