ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

It is the student-athlete's responsibility to be in good standing with no academic or behavioral restrictions. Grades are monitored every two weeks and if students-athletes are giving concern to teachers, then the Athletic Director will meet with the students to decide on next steps. If it is a serious concern, then parents will be contacted by the Athletic Director.

STUDENT BEHAVIOR

Students are expected to conduct themselves at all times in a manner that positively represents them; their family, their team, their coach and the AISA school community. Good sportsmanship is paramount. AISA athletics sets the bar high in terms of student behavior and prides itself on producing polite, well-mannered and respectful student-athletes.

Behavior and or conduct that is not in the best interest of the school, which occurs within the activity setting and/or outside the parameters of the activity situation may constitute grounds for suspension or dismissal from the team, and/or future athletic teams and activities. It may also have repercussions with regard to athletic awards depending on the seriousness of the offense. Students must abide by all NESAC and EAC rules and regulations and the laws of the United Arab Emirates and the laws of the countries being visited.

UNIFORMS

Team uniforms are issued to each team member and are the responsibility of the student-athlete. All items of uniform must be returned in good condition at the end of the season. Should an item be lost or damaged an invoice will be sent home to cover the cost of a replacement. If uniforms are not returned then reports cards will be not be issued.

If seniors have not returned their uniforms, then their check out form will not be signed.

I hereby give permission for my son/daughter to participate on an AISA Athletic team and understand that he/she will be traveling to/from Dubai during the season on chartered busses under the supervision of the coaching staff and if selected to the NESAC travel team he/she may travel to Beirut, Lebanon; Kuwait City, Kuwait; Doha Qatar.
